- O.R.C. 2113.36 provides that the Court shall fix the amount of reasonable attorney fees.
- The above form must be completed and signed by the attorney for the estate. The fees computed in accordance with the above form shall be considered reasonable attorney's fees and will be approved by the Court.
- Attorney fees in excess of those computed in accordance with the above form will not be allowed without an application to the Court, signed by both the fiduciary and the attorney for the estate, itemizing the extraordinary services performed for which additional compensation is sought. An agreement for the payment of additional fees signed by the fiduciary and all the residuary beneficiaries under a will shall be accepted by the court as proof of extraordinary services rendered and no application need be filed.
